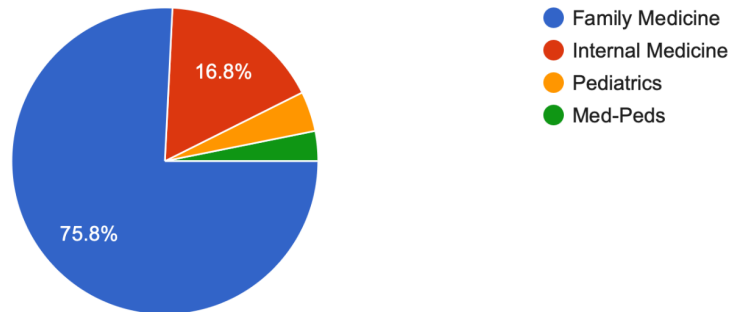


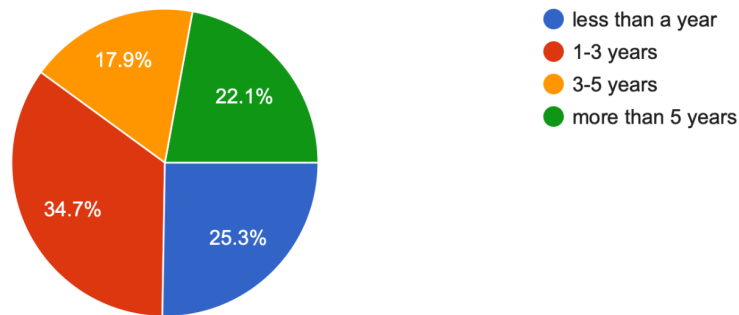
What primary care do you practice?

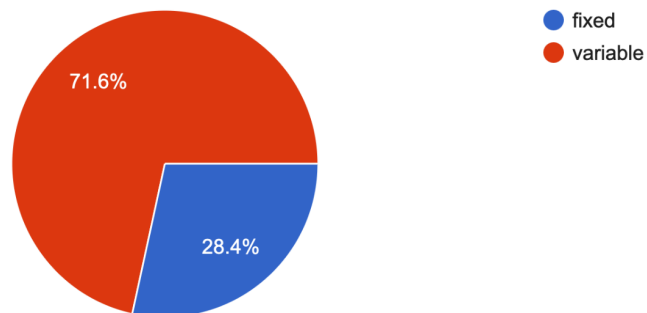
How long have you been in a pure DPC practice?

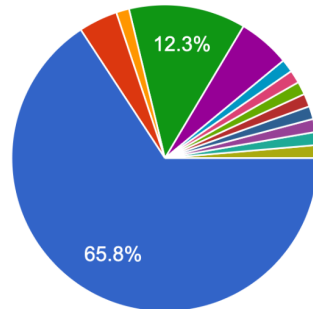
Is your current per member pricing fixed per member or variable?

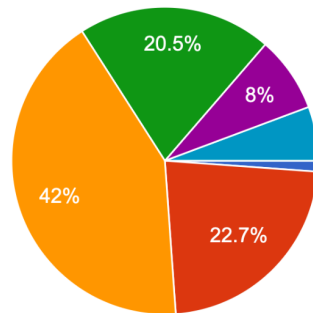

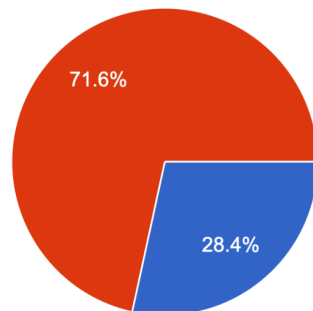

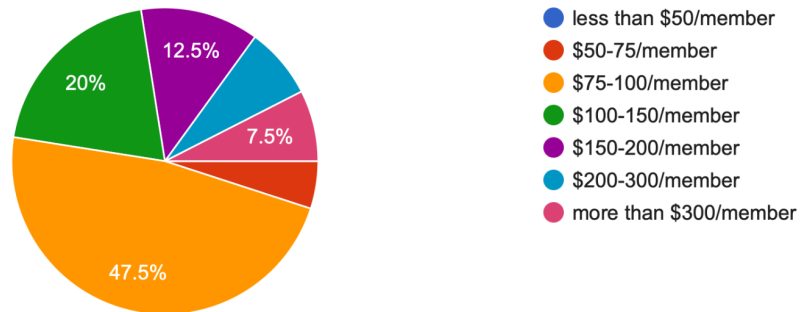

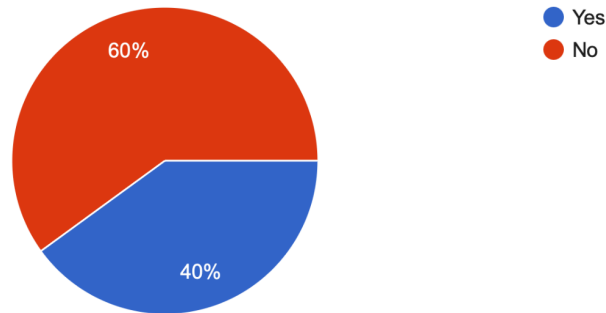

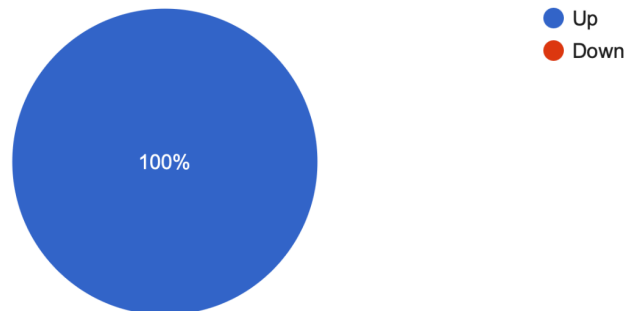

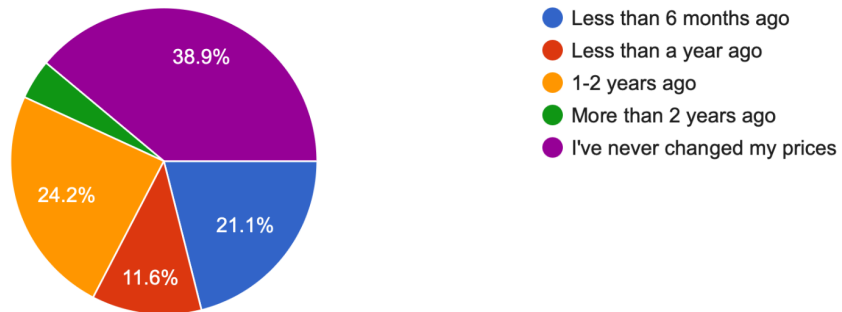

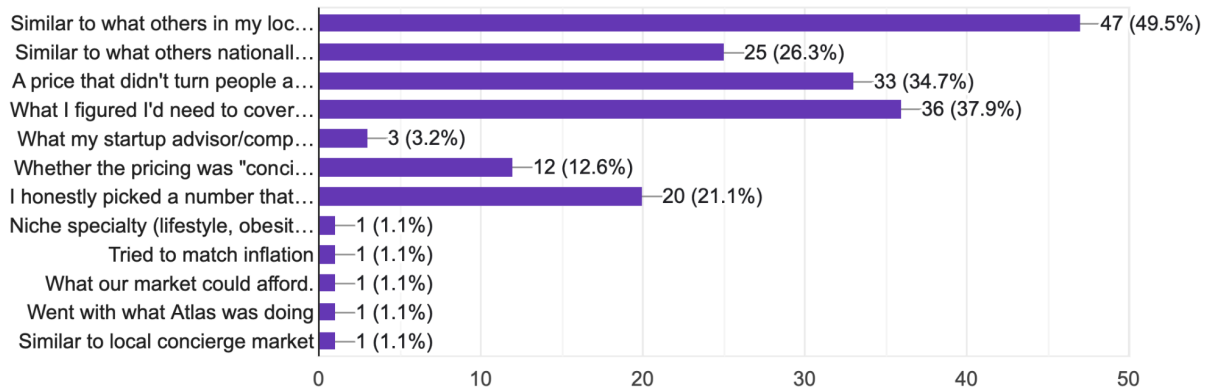

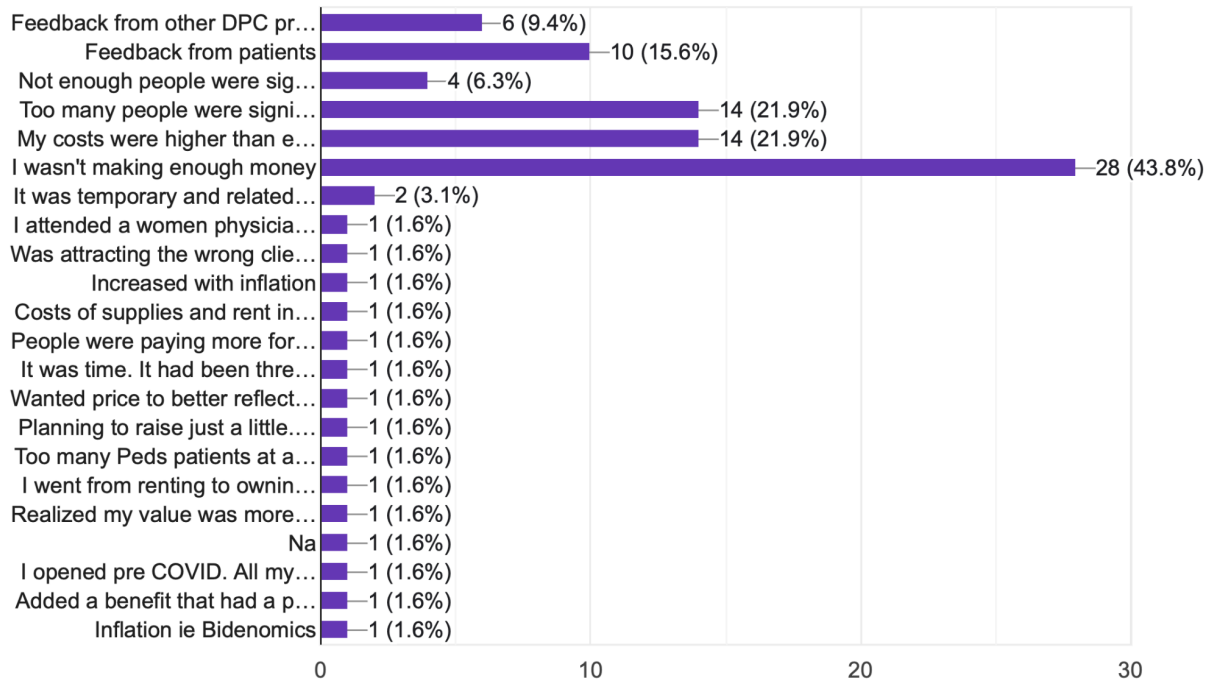

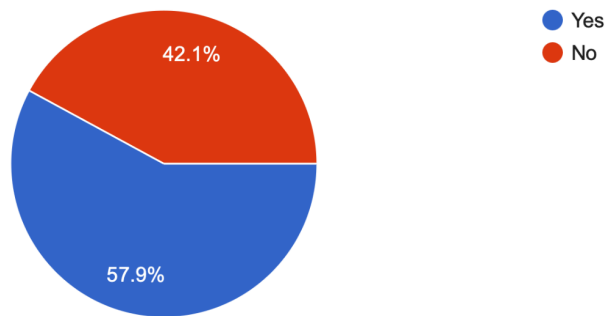

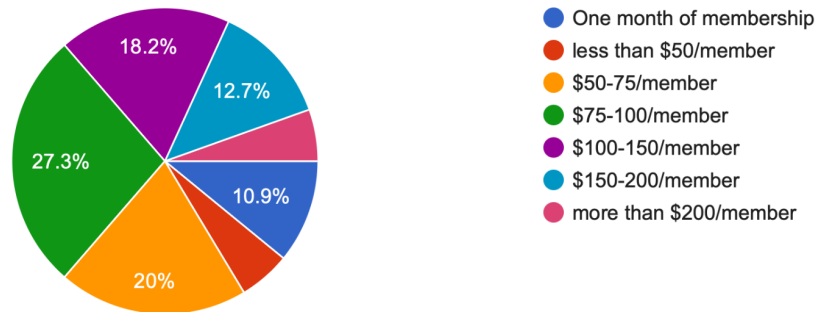

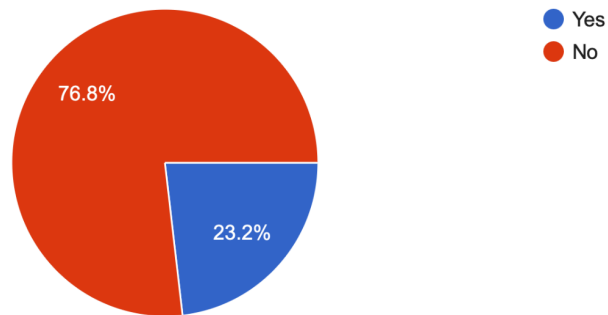

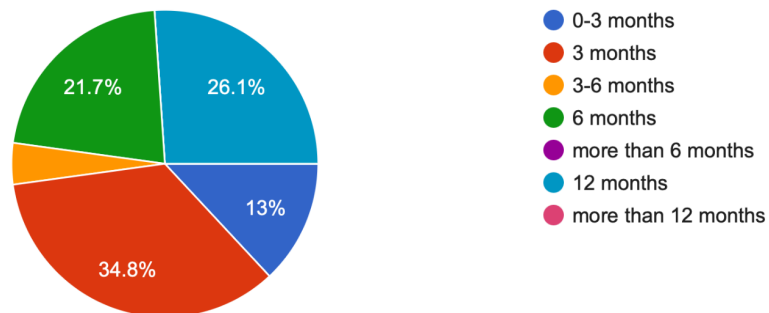

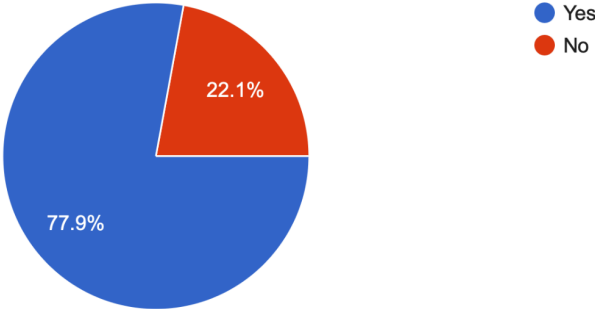
